Strathmore Open Junior Piping Competition

Playing Requirements

1. Events 1 & 2 - 2 parts March tempo of any time signature
2. Events 3 & 4 - Slow Air & Minimum 2 parts March tempo of any time signature
3. Events 5 - Minimum 4 Parts 2/4 March tempo
3. Events 6- 4 Parted 6/8 March tempo
4. Events 7 & 8 - Piobaireachd of own choice
5. Events 9 & 10 - March, Strathspey & Reel own choice with a minimum of 4 parts each
6. Events 11 & 12 - Jig minimum 4 parts
7. Events 13 & 14 - Medley of own choice of tunes lasting between 3 & 5 minutes in total

Rules

1. Competitors will only be allowed to compete in their own age group. Age will be that on the day of the actual competition.
2. Entries are open to all players 18 years and under.
3. No geographical restrictions apply.
4. Players must at all times wear numbered badges given at registration.
5. Events 1 & 2 are confined to players who are not experienced performers and have not won 1st place in a Chanter competition prior to 25/02/2012.
6. Events 3 & 4 are confined to players who have not been placed 1st in a Novice piping competition prior to 25/02/2012.
7. Events 1 & 3 competitors will be allowed to play in both classes.
8. Events 2 & 4 competitors will be allowed to play in both classes.
9. Events 5 competitors will be allowed to play in Event 6 & 11 or 12 according to age.
10. Events 6 & 12 competitors will be allowed to play in both classes.
11. Competitors in piping classes will be allowed a maximum of 2 minutes tuning time on floor.
12. Junior Championship will be decided over events 6, 7, 9 & 11 with a Piobaireachd preference.
13. Senior Championship will be decided over events 6, 8, 10 & 12 with a Piobaireachd preference.
14. All trophies must be signed for and returned 1 month prior to competition unless by prior arrangement with the committee. Failure to return trophies in time may result in competitors being excluded from competition.
15. The judge's decisions are final in all aspects of playing.
16. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for loss or damage to any property belonging to the competitors or members of the public.
17. For all events played on the bagpipe, competitors should be in highland dress including jacket or waistcoat, tie, bonnet or Glengarry and appropriate footwear. These should be also worn for the prize giving.
18. Competitors must be ready to compete in accordance with the published order of play.
19. Tuning rooms and grounds are to be kept tidy at all times.
20. All competitors must agree to be bound by these rules and entry requirements.

Other Information

1. Playing requirements and rules will be on display, at the venue, on the day of competition.
2. The draw will be available to view on the City of Brechin Pipe Band website by 22/02/2012 - www.cityofbrechinpipeband.co.uk
3. Entry fee of £3 per Event or £10 if playing in 4 or more events, money to be returned with entry form. *Cheques made payable to 'Strathmore Piping Society'*
4. Entry fee of £3 per spectator
5. Full Canteen facilities available, Raffle on day.
